Readings for 19<sup>th</sup> August 2018: *Trinity 12*

### First Reading:

### Psalm 111

- <sup>1</sup>Praise the LORD! I will give thanks to the LORD with my whole heart, in the company of the upright, in the congregation.
- <sup>2</sup>Great are the works of the LORD, studied by all who delight in them.
- <sup>3</sup>Full of splendour and majesty is His work and His righteousness endures for ever.
- <sup>4</sup>He has caused his wondrous works to be remembered; the LORD is gracious and merciful. <sup>5</sup>He provides food for those who fear Him; He remembers His covenant for ever. <sup>6</sup>He has shown His people the power of His works, in giving them the inheritance of the nations.
- <sup>7</sup>The works of His hands are faithful and just; all His precepts are trustworthy; <sup>8</sup>they are established for ever and ever, to be performed with faithfulness and uprightness.
- <sup>9</sup>He sent redemption to his people; He has commanded His covenant for ever. Holy and awesome is his name!
- <sup>10</sup>The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; all those who practise it have a good understanding. His praise endures for ever!

### Second Reading:

### Ephesians 5: 15 – 21

- <sup>15</sup>Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, <sup>16</sup>making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. <sup>17</sup>Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. <sup>18</sup>And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit, <sup>19</sup>addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart, <sup>20</sup>giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>21</sup>submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.

### Gospel Reading:

### John 6: 51 – 58

- <sup>51</sup>I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live for ever. And the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh.”
- <sup>52</sup>The Jews then disputed among themselves, saying, “How can this man give us His flesh to eat?” <sup>53</sup>So Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. <sup>54</sup>Whoever feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life and I will raise him up on the last day.
- <sup>55</sup>For my flesh is true food and my blood is true drink.
- <sup>56</sup>Whoever feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me and I in him.
- <sup>57</sup>As the living Father sent me and I live because of the Father, so whoever feeds on me, he also will live because of me.
- <sup>58</sup>This is the bread that came down from heaven, not like the bread the fathers ate and died. Whoever feeds on this bread will live for ever.”

Almighty and everlasting God, You are always more ready to hear than we to pray and to give more than either we desire or deserve: pour down upon us the abundance of Your mercy, forgiving us those things of which our conscience is afraid and giving us those good things which we are not worthy to ask but through the merits and mediation of Jesus Christ Your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with You, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. **Amen.**
